Cost - Our courses cost £45 for the day and include materials.

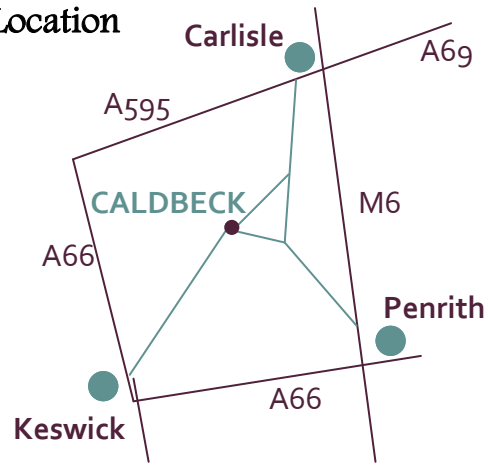
Time -All courses run from 10am to 4pm
